**NASHVILLE CHILDREN'S THEATRE PRESENTS *GO, DOG. GO!***

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Nashville Children's Theatre will present *Go, Dog. Go!*, beginning March 11 and running through April 6, 2008.

This Seuss-styled classic picture book has been an early favorite of children since 1961. On stage, the book bursts to life in an explosion of movement, a kaleidoscope of color and a circus-wagon load of clowning. Red Dog, Blue Dog, Yellow Dog and Green Dog bark, snorkel, scratch, drive, howl at the moon and live on a Ferris wheel that never stops. It's a big dog party that is appropriate for children ages 3 and up.

*Go, Dog. Go!* is adapted by Steven Dietz and Allison Gregory from the book by P.D. Eastman. The cast features Peter Vann, Shawn Knight, Ross Brooks, Misty Lewis, Brooke Bryant, R. Alex Murray and Marin Miller. Julee Baber will direct the production, scenic design is by Mitch Massaro, lighting design is by Scott Leathers and costume design is by Patricia Taber.

Weekend performances are scheduled at 2:30 p.m. on March 15, 22, 23, 29 and 30 and April 5 and 6. A spring break matinee performance is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 19. School performances run Monday through Friday at 10 a.m. and 11:45 a.m. All performances are open to the public, and reservations are recommended. Individual ticket prices are \$11 per child (ages 2 to 17), \$15 per adult and free for children under 2 years old. Season passes and group discounts are also available. A sign-interpreted performance is scheduled for Saturday, April 5.

Target will sponsor a free family reception and hands-on art activities before the show on Saturday, March 15. The event is part of the Target Family Time Series and is nearly sold out. Reservations are required.

On Friday, April 4, NCT will have a special performance of *Go, Dog. Go!* for adults only. Tickets are \$25, and a reception will begin at 5:30 p.m. before the 6:30 p.m. show. This event is open to ages 21 and up.
